



PROPOSED TERMINAL 5 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT AVAILABLE FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT

The Port of Seattle with the Northwest Seaport Alliance (NWSA) is proposing improvements to marine cargo facilities at Terminal 5. The Port of Seattle, as lead agency under the State Environmental Protection Act (SEPA), is preparing an environmental impact statement (EIS) for public review.
